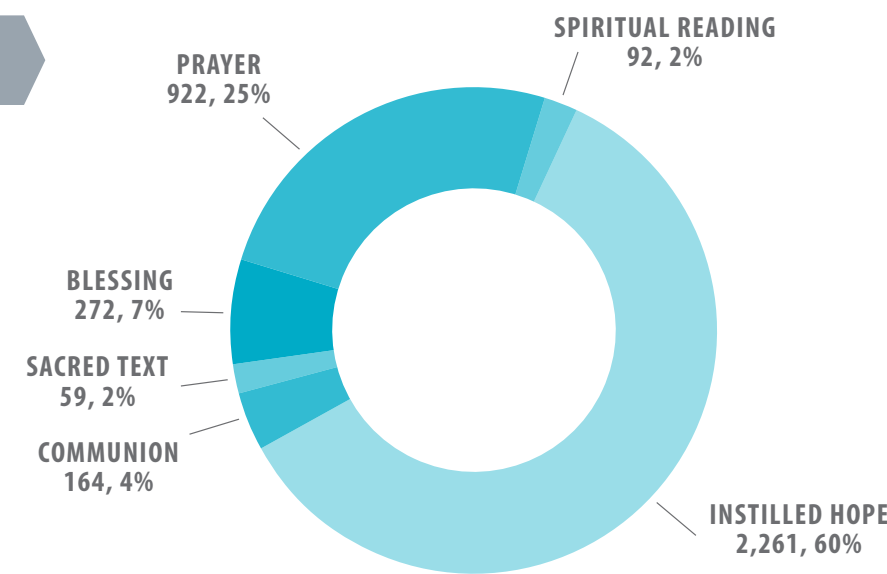

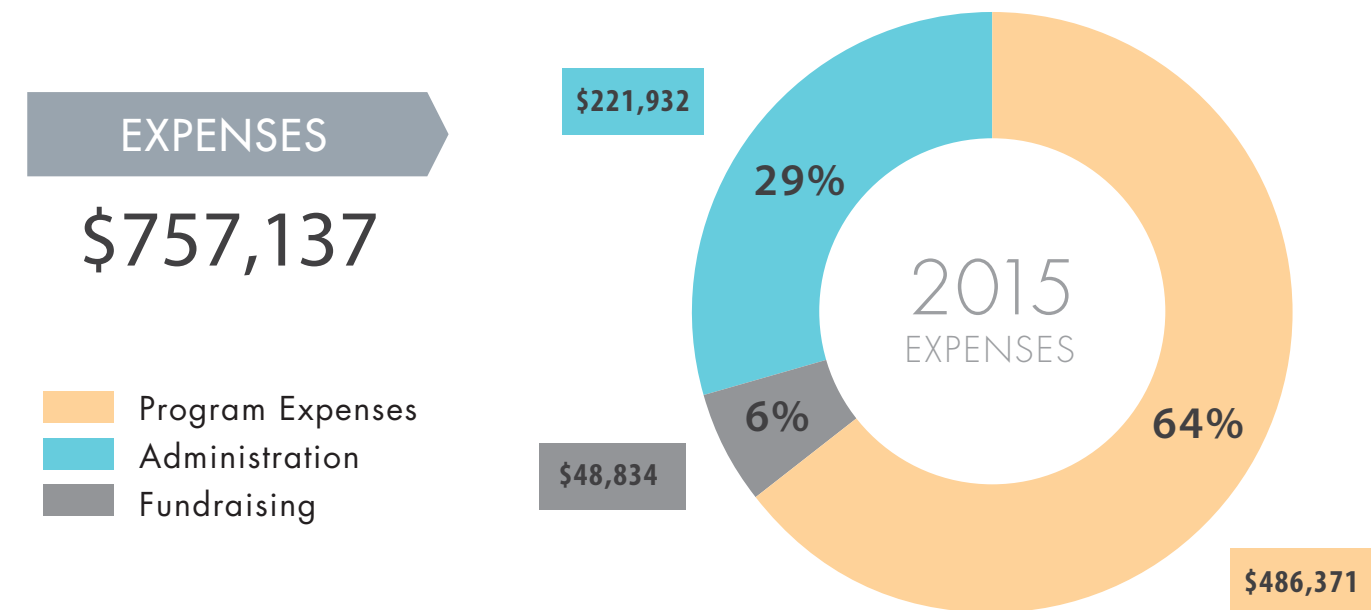
## INCOME
